A very limited number of covered permanent stalls will be available for \$50 per stall (includes shavings) for the duration of the show.

GENERAL INFORMATION

PLEASE BE AWARE!

This is a new year... All release forms for 2013 are now void.

A new form for 2014 must be signed by each participant of legal age or by the parent/legal guardian of any minor for any show at Hidden Lake Farm.

Trainers may NOT sign in lieu of parents, as this is a legal document.

Please go to our website, <u>hiddenlakefarm.net</u> and download a new form for each participant! Please have signed forms when you register.

1. We offer an early entry fee-\$15 per class if we receive your entries by 6pm Wednesday prior to each show, so that we can plan the show around you with the appropriate combination of rings, jumps, judges, equipment, and personnel.

After 6pm every Wednesday prior to each show the regular entry fee of \$20 per class will apply to all e-mail entries and at the desk on show days. For the reduced fee, REGISTER EARLY! You will save money as well as help

us create a better show for you.

- A \$15 awards fee per show and \$5 paramedic fee per show day will be required for each horse/rider combination participating at each of the shows.
- 2. Concession tabs are always welcome, but should be paid at the concession stand.
- 3. Chaps and paddock boots are acceptable. If the weather is cold, warm jackets are encouraged. Show coats are not required.
- 4. Riders must wear protective helmets at all times while mounted. Please be sure use of tack (nose bands, bits, martingales, etc.) strictly adheres to USEF rules.
- 5. A horse/rider combination may only cross-enter into hunter divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference, except the limit divisions. This includes eq flat and under saddle classes. No 6" rule for jumpers.
- 6. Dogs must be on a leash at all times
- 7. Children must be supervised by an adult.
- 8. Campfire cookin' and refreshments will be available on the show grounds.
- 9. Management reserves the right to change, cancel, or combine classes, alter courses, and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries.
 - * Same schedule for all three shows *

Coggins Reguirement

Texas law requires each show facility to obtain a current Coggins report for each horse admitted to the show grounds. This may be emailed prior to the show or brought to the show desk. Simply providing the Coggins number and date is not sufficient. We must verify that the Coggins is current and retain accurate records in case we are audited. Any horse arriving on HLF property without a current Coggins will be required to leave the premises.

Coggins reports are required at registration for each show. We will not keep records from one show to the next in this or future series.

There will be absolutely no exceptions to this requirement. Please do not bring a horse to the farm if you do not have a copy verifying that the Coggins

is current. Paper copies are preferred over viewing the Coggins on cell phones. However, cell phone reports will be accepted.

Thank you for your support of our mandatory compliance with this Texas state law.

HIDDEN LAKE FARM will be open to horse show participants for schooling before each show starts. There will be a \$35 schooling fee for those NOT participating in the show.

WARNING

Under Texas law (Chapter 87, Civil Practices and Remedies Code), an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

END-OF-SERIES CHAMPIONS

END-OF-SERIES CHAMPIONS

END-OF-SERIES CHAMPIONS will be announced for each division at the conclusion of the last show. No end-of-series points will be awarded for warm-up classes.

NOTE: A division must have at least 3 entries in all 3 classes that earn points (second, third, and fourth classes) in 2 of 3 shows in order to award end-of-series prizes. Each horse (or rider in Div I-III) must participate in the same three classes that earn points in the same division in at least 2 of the 3 shows to be eligible for end-of-series prizes.

No horse/rider combinations are required, and points go to the horse in all hunter and jumper divisions, and to the rider in the poles and crossrails divisions.


