STALLS AVAILABLE!

A very limited number of covered permanent stalls will be available for \$50 per stall (includes shavings and fans). Please reserve your stall as soon as possible. Stall fees are nonrefundable.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. We offer an early entry fee-\$15 per class if we receive your entries by 10pm Wednesday prior to each show, so that we can plan the show

around you with the appropriate combination of rings, jumps, judges, equipment, and personnel.

After 10pm every Wednesday prior to each show the regular entry fee of \$20 per class will apply to all phone/e-mail entries and at the desk on show days. For the reduced fee, REGISTER EARLY! You will save money as well as help us create a better show for you.

A \$15 awards fee and \$5 paramedic fee per show day will be required for each horse/rider combination per show day.

Riders must wear protective hard hats at all times while mounted. Please wear cool, casual shirts. No Coats! Chaps are allowed.

2. To avoid disqualification, please be sure tack (nose bands, bits, martingales, etc.) strictly adheres to USEF rules.

3. Dogs must be on a leash at all times

4. Children must be supervised by an adult.

5. Refreshments will be available on the show grounds.

6. Management reserves the right to change, cancel, or combine classes, alter courses, and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries.

Release Forms for 2015

The liability release form (a legal document) must be signed by a parent or legal guardian. Your trainer cannot sign for your child. Please go to our website, hiddenlakefarm.net and download the form, sign it, then send it with your child or trainer. Once we receive the signed release form, we will keep it on file for the current year.

Coggins Requirement

Texas law requires each show facility to obtain a current Coggins report for each horse admitted to the show grounds. This may be emailed prior to the show or brought to the show desk. Simply providing the Coggins number and date is not sufficient. We must verify that the Coggins is current and retain accurate records in case we are audited. Any horse arriving on HLF property without a current Coggins will be required to leave the premises.

Coggins reports are required at registration for each show. We will not keep records from one show to the next in this or future series.

There will be absolutely no exceptions to this requirement. Please do not bring a horse to the farm if you do not have a copy verifying that the Coggins is current. Paper copies are preferred over viewing the Coggins on cell phones. However, cell phone reports will be accepted.

Thank you for your support of our mandatory compliance with this Texas state law.

HIDDEN LAKE FARM will be open to horse show participants for schooling before each show starts. There will be a \$35 schooling fee for those NOT participating in the show.

Eligibility:

In Divisions I, II, III, the same rider must compete in all 3 of the point classes in the same division in 3 of the 5 shows. In all other divisions, the same horse must compete in all 3 of the point classes in the same division in 3 of the 5 shows. There are no horse/rider combination requirements. Eq classes in Div IV and higher do not count toward end-of-series prizes.

Divisions must have at least 3 entries in all 3 point classes in 3 of the 5 shows for the end-of-series prizes to be awarded.

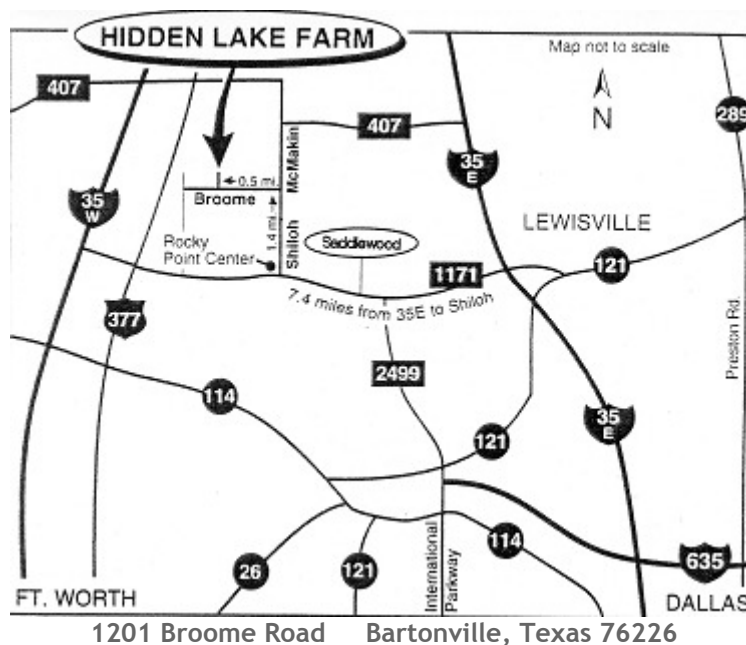
